



CHESS MERIT BADGE CLINIC

Saturday May 25th 9AM—5PM – Atherton Hall

Registration on Double Knot ..Class size is limited to 40 Scouts. Class fee of \$5, for drinks, snacks, materials, etc.

Scouts must know how to play Chess.. “basic playing ability” is fine, as we are all ‘learning’. Clinic is designed for “learning” to be a **CHESS MONSTER**.

First half of clinic will be a review of Chess Merit Badge requirements. Scouts will learn “Chess Notation”, how to use a Chess Clock, basic Strategy, Traps, Tricks, etc. Second half of clinic will be a Chess Tournament (to fulfill Req. #6) Tournament will be played using Chess Clocks and Chess Notation.

The Chess Merit Badge pamphlet is an excellent text book, Scouts should read it prior to attending clinic. Also, Scouts should down load a copy of the Chess MB work book.. at MeritBadge.org Complete the work book, prior to clinic. We retain more when we write it down. Bring work book to class. Get a good night’s sleep.

Class A Uniform.. Bring a sack lunch, water bottle, a note book and a writing stick. Cold drinks and snacks will be provided.

Recruiting Event Scouts may bring a friend of Scouting Age. (They must be registered on Double Knot)
