Wreaths Across America – Annual Ceremonial Wreaths Laying to Honor Veterans

When: Saturday, December 15th, 2018

Time: 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM

Where: Miramar or Fort Rosecrans National Cemeteries, Greenwood Memorial Park, Valley Center Cemetery

What you'll be doing: Placing ceremonial Remembrance wreaths sponsored by various local businesses, groups and individuals on the grave sites of our military veterans at local cemeteries.

Special Requirements: This is a family event and volunteers under the age of 10 should be accompanied by an adult. A formal ceremony starts at 9:00 AM SHARP, lasts 40 minutes. This follows with laying of the wreaths by everyone. Parking can be limited so arrival by 8:00 AM is best. At Fort Rosecrans parking will be in a Navy lot with shuttles to the cemetery. Comfortable shoes and clothing are recommended, and this event takes place regardless of weather.
