*Chemistry:

Please bring a copy of Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for an insecticide AND a paint. Everyone needs to use the same two products. With parent/guardian help, go to: <https://www.adama.com/documents/444852/445866/diazinon-ag500-sds.pdf> and <https://www.paintdocs.com/docs/webPDF.jsp?SITEID=CMUS&prodno=042475002288&doctype=SDS&lang=2&cntry=US>. Each should be about 4 to 6 printed pages. No need to visit a store or buy anything - just find online and print out the MSDS. We will discuss this in the merit badge session.

**First Aid:

Prepare a 1st Aid kit for your home and bring it with you, or a large photo of it, and be prepared to discuss contents. Scouts should have met 1st Aid requirements for Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, and 1st Class ranks prior to Fair.

***Fire Safety: **Visit a fire department prior to the Fair.**
