*Chemistry:

Please bring a copy of the Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for an insecticide AND a paint. For convenience, please use the same two products. With parent/guardian help, go to: <https://www.adama.com/documents/444852/445866/diazinon-ag500-sds.pdf> and <https://www.paintdocs.com/docs/webPDF.jsp?SITEID=CMUS&prodno=042475002288&doctype=SDS&lang=2&cntry=US>. Each should be about 4 to 6 printed pages. No need to visit a store or buy anything - just find online and print out the SDS. We will discuss these in the merit badge session.

In order to complete the Chemistry merit badge, the Scout must have previously done Requirement 7. Only one option is required (a, c, or d is preferred, but 7b will be acceptable if a visit to a lab, industrial agency, or agricultural agency is not possible). If doing requirement 7b, there are two parts: two kinds of work done by any of the positions, and listing the education/training for EACH of the four positions) - both questions must be answered. The Scout must bring a copy of the Chemistry Merit Badge Worksheet to the Fair, to be filled out completely during the session at the Fair. Do not forget a pen or pencil.

**First Aid:

Prepare a 1st Aid kit for your home and bring it with you, or a large photo of it, and be prepared to discuss contents. Scouts should have met 1st Aid requirements for Tenderfoot, 2nd Class, and 1st Class ranks prior to Fair.

*****Fire Safety: Visit a fire department prior to the Fair.**

******Horsemanship: Located at 13036 Willow Rd, Pillsbury Ranch Riding Club (where overnight camping is held). It is a ten minute walk from the Scout Fair area.**
