

Scout Fair Ticket Sales

Frequently Asked Questions

Scout Fair Ticket Sales is a great way to earn money for your unit. For every ticket sold, your unit will earn a \$4 commission for every \$10 coupon/ticket card sold.

This year the Scout Fair 2009 will introduce a credit card sized ticket which serves as your ticket into the fair. The ticket is a plastic card with a secret password that can be used to print coupons for many popular retailers. There is no limit to the number of coupons that can be printed for a period of one year. The price of a ticket is \$10.00.

How does my unit close out after the sale ends?

*Turn in all forms and copies of deposits made to your District Ticket Chair or to Council. Deposit all money to Union Bank with your unit # on the deposit slip.

Can I close out at the Scout Fair?

*YES! Check your program guide to find where the booth will be located.

Can we still sell tickets after the first turn in date?

*You may keep working towards incentives after the Early-Bird turn in. Commission and prizes can be earned through April 18, 2009.

When do we get the prizes?

*Prizes will be determined and distributed to your Unit Ticket Chairman two weeks after your unit closes out.

Is the plastic card my admittance into the Fair?

*Yes! You can remove the white banner at any time, just bring card to present as your family admittance.

What happens if my unit loses the coupon card?

* Your Unit is financially responsible for every ticket received. Your unit will be charged \$10 for every ticket not returned to Council.

How does my unit report which prizes they want if they earn an option?

*Keep track of the prizes earned using the Prize tracking form. Turn in your units sellers information when you close out and the details of the prize requested.

What if a youth who earned a Big Spin opportunity cannot attend the Scout Fair?

* An alternative date will be determined at Council head quarters shortly after the fair.

What if my unit needs more coupon cards?

*Contact your District Ticket Chair to check out more coupons or call Council.
